The aim of the Conference is to support municipalities in improving their competences in strengthening and developing local democracy through youth participation in decision-making.

Specific objectives of the Conference:

- To recognise the roles of municipalities engaging young people in decision-making as a way to improve local democracy,
- To take stock of the outcomes and lessons learnt from the *Democracy Reloading* activities between 2015-2020.
- To officially introduce and launch the Democracy Reloading Online Toolkit*,
- To identify ways of using and promoting the online Toolkit,
- To support the development of relevant national and European networks of stakeholders, practitioners of youth participation in municipal decision-making and local democracy.

*Democracy Reloading is a brand and a program of the national agencies of the Erasmus+ Youth Program, grounded in the values and principles of democracy, human rights, equality and the rule of law. It is aiming to support municipalities in improving local democracy through engaging young people in decision-making and using Erasmus+ funding. In the last year of the program an online Toolkit was created that is based on a set of 24 competences. The 24 competencies are required for a local (municipal) or regional government to design, implement and evaluate a successful youth participation structure, to engage young people in the decision-making and develop local democracy.
