**Participants:** One civil servant and youth representative (max 2 from each city).

#### Recommendations for travelling to Narva:

You can directly fly to Tallinn Airport. Then you can take taxi (it is the most convenient variant for you to get to the bus station or to the train station). Recommend you use airport's partner taxis waiting at the official taxi park of the airport (Tulika Takso, Tallink Takso, Airport Taxi - whose cars will be waiting for passengers right in front of the arrival terminal doors). Before you start your ride, make sure that the rate is acceptable to you and, if possible, ask the driver for the estimated fare. Usually it is ca 10 eur for getting to the bus station and a bit expensive for getting to the train station.

You can choose one of 2 variants of how to get from Tallinn to Narva: by bus or by train.
