Niels Højberg is chief executive in the City of Aarhus, and has been so since 2008. Prior to that he was the Managing Director of Aarhus University. In his career he has had positions as the top official in regions and municipalities and had his first job in the Ministry of Finance in Copenhagen. He hold a Master's Degree in Political Science and BA in Philosophy from Aarhus University and an M.Phil. from Glasgow University. From 2013-2015 he was the Chairman of the Danish Association of Local Government Executives. Niels Højberg has been the co-author of a number of publication mainly on leadership in the public sector and has twice been awarded "Municipal Decision Maker of the Year" in Denmark.

Dr Ulf Kämpfer (SPD) has been Lord Mayor of the Land Capital Kiel since 24 April 2014. The lawyer and Secretary of State of the Schleswig-Holstein Ministry of the Environment won 63.12 per cent of the votes as the joint candidate for SPD, the Greens (Grünen) and SSW in the fifth direct elections for Kiel's Lord Mayor on 23 March 2014.

Lord Mayor Kämpfer is also responsible for the industry sector at Kiel Town Hall. His department includes the Press and Public Relations Office, the Legal Office, the Audit Office, the Department of Economic Affairs, the Office for Equality and Land Capital Kiel's investment management company Eigenbetrieb Beteiligungen.
