



STEAM in Kindergarten

Webinar on the 15.11.2022, 13.00 – 14.30 (Eastern European Time)

The UBC Learning Cities Commission warmly welcomes you to join the first webinar of this Autumn. The webinar will be organized on the 15th of November, 13.00-14.30 EET.

In this webinar "STEAM in Kindergarten", Suvi Venäläinen and Suvi Aflecht will give a presentation that addresses STEAM in kindergartens in Turku, and share their best practices. During the presentation they share the practical aspects of including science and digital education in early childhood education, and early childhood education and pre-primary education curricula.
